Did you know that

- Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) programs improve student achievement scores 11-17 percentile points (CASEL, 2008).
- When students participate in after-school programs grounded in SEL learning, they showed significant improvements in: positive feelings toward school, positive social interactions with peers and adults, as well as improved grades and academic achievement (Durlak, Weissberg, & CASEL, 2007).

Where are we?

LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (LAUSD) - Our curriculum has been operating in LAUSD since summer of 2011. We currently reach over 2000+ students and operate in 20+ elementary schools with plans to expand in the 2013-2014 school year. In addition, they've asked us to create a solution for their middle schools.

WASHINGTON DC - In January 2013 we launched our SHAKTI Warriors curriculum in the Howard County public schools (greater Washington DC metro area). We increased from 1 pilot school to 4 schools in an 8 week period. They've seen such a positive impact they selected SHAKTI Warriors as their Character Development curriculum. They are extending our curriculum to all of their schools (10+) in the fall of 2013.

CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS (CPS) - In 2012 SHAKTI Warriors was piloted in five Chicago Public Schools. Based on that success, we were chosen as their preferred vendor for Social and Emotional Learning literacy curriculum by CPS Board of Education.

What are we? Digital Learning at its finest!

Our curriculum is comprised of 2 components: our 'Hands-On Learning' Curriculum - (SW Kit) and our 'Digital Learning' Curriculum - (SW Online Academy). Our program takes a Whole Child approach towards child development. The goal of our curriculum is to evolve kids, ages 8-12, from *super heroes* to *real world heroes* by motivating them to develop a Hero's

Body, Mind, Heart and Community.


